This will increase maintenance and generalization of skills across people and settings. A collaborative process is established for collecting and monitoring data within the guidelines of both educational and medical legal requirements (i.e., HIPAA, FERPA) with the family consent. Providers, families, and school staff are working towards the most functional and independent community setting for the student.
