BENEFITS:

Ignite Afterschool's vision is that every young person in every community will benefit from the power of afterschool. As Minnesota's National Afterschool Association affiliate and representative in the 50 State Afterschool Network, Ignite brings afterschool stakeholders together to address race, income and geography-based access gaps to high quality afterschool through advocacy, issue education, partnership building, professional development and continuous program improvement.

Ignite Afterschool believes that, to achieve our vision that every youth in every community benefits from the power of afterschool, we must address systemic inequities based on race. We use a racial equity framework to guide organizational policies, processes and decision making.

This position has dedicated funding through June 2024 with plans to continue the position dependent on meeting fundraising goals.

JOB SUMMARY:

During the 2023-2024 school year, Ignite Afterschool will launch a new school-age care (before/afterschool & summer programs for young people in K-6th grade) accreditation and continuous improvement program. Ignite Afterschool believes that young people have better experiences and achieve stronger outcomes when they participate in *high quality* afterschool and summer programs. We seek a *Program Specialist for School-Age Care (SAC) and Continuous Improvement* who is passionate about supporting afterschool and summer programs to strengthen quality through continuous program improvement (CPI). The *Program Specialist for School-Age Care (SAC) and Continuous Improvement* will be responsible for implementation of this new accreditation and continuous improvement program.

The *Program Specialist's* primary function is to support school-age care program providers to successfully participate in the accreditation and program improvement process and to implement program improvement, coaching and other program capacity building supports. This work will build off of *Believe It. Build It. Minnesota's Guide to Effective Afterschool Practices* and the *Making Meaning with Multiple Data Sets* or M3 continuous program improvement cycle. *The Program Specialist's* secondary functions include 1) supporting implementation of the annual Making Meaning with Multiple Data Sets Continuous Program Improvement cycle and 2) acting as the organizations primary staff coordinator for Ignite's Salesforce customer relationship management (CRM) system, which tracks network partner participation in accreditation, continuous improvement and professional development opportunities. As a network, Ignite Afterschool is only successful when we have positive and healthy partnerships with afterschool programs and afterschool intermediaries across the state. The Program Specialist must be committed to equity and skilled at working with others, building positive relationships, and engaging our partners in efforts that promote youth program quality.

In the first year, the Program Specialist will:

- Participate in final implementation steps and wrap-up of Ignite's Interim SAC Accreditation Program that will conclude June 30th, 2023 (this process provided an interim accreditation solution until a permanent accreditation program is developed and launched.
 - Attend and participate in the SAC Accreditation Design Work Group meetings (group of SAC stakeholders informing development of the new accreditation program)

- Attend/shadow accreditation site visits with Interim SAC Accreditation Program validators (review program site evidence towards meeting accreditation standards)
- Ensure participating program sites receive final accreditation status results by June 30th, 2023 and ensure accreditation status is recorded in Salesforce CRM
- Coordinate development and use of both program and marketing/promotional materials and ensure they
 align with Ignite Afterschool's brand.
 - Coordinate materials production timeline and work with contracted copywriter and graphic designer to design final SAC Accreditation & Continuous Improvement Program materials
 - Coordinate development and sharing of promotional materials and other strategies that promote participation in the SAC Accreditation Program by school-age care program stakeholders across the state
 - Facilitate engagement of additional, appropriate Ignite Afterschool staff and partners in SAC
 Accreditation & Continuous Improvement Program materials design and promotion
- Coordinate launch and implementation of newly developed SAC Accreditation & Continuous Improvement Program
 - Develop and manage an implementation workplan with timeline.
 - Complete and submit an application to the State of Minnesota Department of Human Services to ensure newly developed accreditation qualifies for increased Child Care Assistance Program reimbursements rates.
 - Manage registration process for programs participating in the accreditation program and track accreditation status in the CRM.
 - Contribute to the design of and provide technical assistance, workshops and coaching to school age care
 programs participating in the accreditation program.
 - o Coordinate all relevant contractors working to support the SAC Accreditation Program
 - Gather feedback from participating programs to inform continuous improvement of the accreditation program.

ADDITIONAL JOB RESPONSIBILITIES BEYOND YEAR ONE:

- Coordinate school-age care program providers successful participation in the accreditation and program
 improvement process and implement program improvement, coaching and other program capacity building
 supports.
- Provide logistics management for annual implementation and improvement of the *Making Meaning with Multiple Data Sets (M3)* program improvement cycle which includes managing M3 Huddle process facilitator licenses and contracts, ensuring M3 huddles take place statewide, collecting evaluation and participation data in regards to annual participation in M3.
- Mange use of Ignite's Salesforce CRM, especially as it relates to properly recording and documenting
 participation in continuous improvement, accreditation and professional development opportunities including
 development of "how to" written guides to support staff training on use of CRM.
- Engage in strong financial management, sustainability, and network evaluation.
 - Work within approved project budgets and submit invoices and track expenses.
 - Contribute to grant prospecting, writing, and grant reporting as relates to job functions.
 - Prepare presentations, draft briefing memos, and lead workshops and trainings at industry and regional conferences
 - Oversee and manage the work of relevant national service volunteers (i.e. VISTA, Promise Fellow), interns, and contractors contributing to work under the positions' purview
 - Work with relevant staff to track activities in a CRM and use CRM for network evaluation
- Perform all duties, and ensure relevant contractors also perform all duties, in compliance with relevant data privacy and integrity policies and participate in necessary data privacy and integrity trainings.
